

Requirements Regarding Alcohol on Premises

- A copy of your “DRAM Shop” Insurance, also known as “Liquor Liability” is needed if providing *or* selling alcohol when applying for the license.

Requirements if Selling Alcohol ~

- Temporary Liquor License application request filled out not less than 30 days prior to your event. (2 pages)
- \$25.00 fee

Requirements if Providing Alcohol

You will need to write a letter to the Mayor’s office requesting a “Celebratory Toast” letter. You must provide details of event you are having such as date, time, and what your event is. We will need a copy for your file and you must be able to produce this anytime during your event should the police or Liquor Commissioner stop in. Mail letters to:

Temporary Liquor License

Temporary license to sell alcohol at retail may be granted to organized clubs, societies, associations, fraternal organizations, duly constituted churches, or other not-for-profit organizations. A [temporary liquor license](#) may be issued for one, two, or three consecutive days.
